Learn about upcoming short-term water shut-offs in the Chinatown/International District

The First Hill Streetcar Project includes the installation of a new water main on S. Jackson Street between 5th Avenue S. and 14th Avenue S. This construction requires that the water in some buildings be temporarily shut off. Shut-offs will begin in mid-August and continue through the end of 2013.

Please join us for an open house to learn about these planned water shut-offs co-hosted by Seattle Public Utilities, the First Hill Streetcar project team, and community organizations of the Chinatown/International District.

What you will learn by attending the open house:

- What buildings will have their water shut-off
- Approximately how many water shut-offs you will experience in the coming months
- How will you be informed of a water shut-off in your building
- How to prepare for having your water shut-off
