The Center City Connector team has been spreading the word about the project. This fall, we talked with **over 900** people at **19** outreach events in South Lake Union, Chinatown-International District, Pioneer Square, and Downtown. We visited neighborhood organizations, engaged business owners and residents by going door-to-door, and held pop-up sessions at Westlake Park, Pike Place Market, Japantown, and the Harbor Steps during lunch hours.

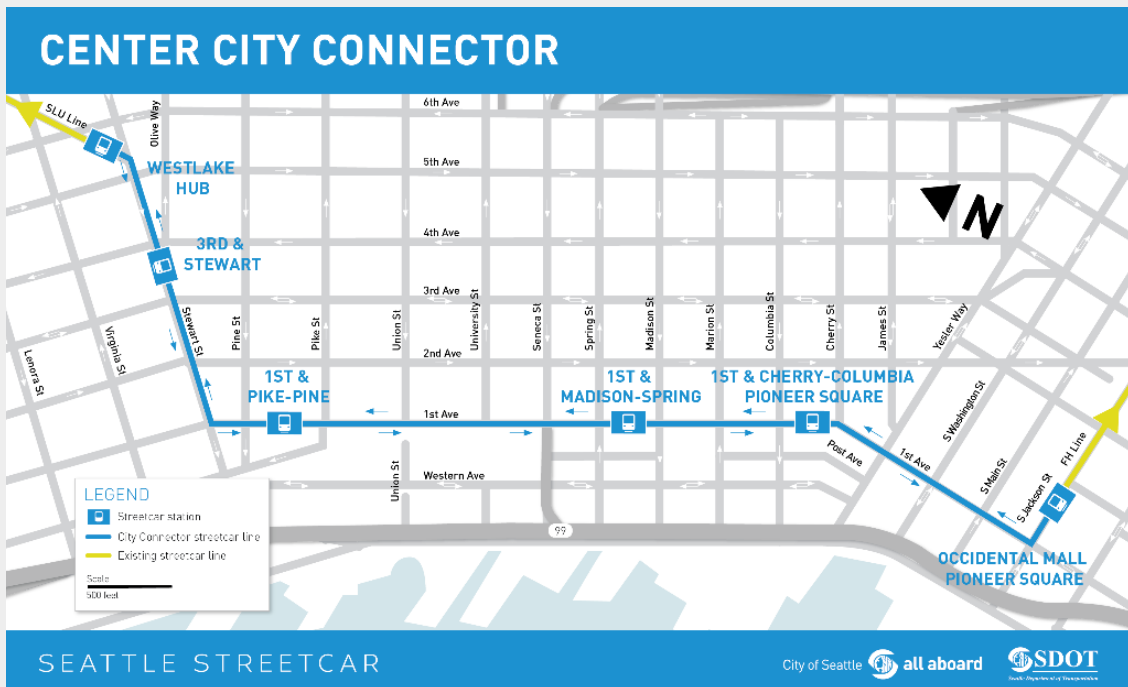


City Center Connector Outreach Team members talked with passengers at the Japantown Streetcar Station

Community members asked about the project timeline, planned expansion of the Operations Maintenance Facility in South Lake Union, new station locations, parking, traffic patterns, loading and unloading for businesses, business access during construction, and more.

Completed and Upcoming Utility Location Work

In preparation for the Center City Connector, we completed utility location work at and near intersections along 1st Ave starting at Jackson St and moving north to Stewart St. Beginning in early January, we will continue utility location work primarily along Stewart St. Work at each location is anticipated to last a few hours.
