CITY CONNECTOR PROJECT By the Numbers

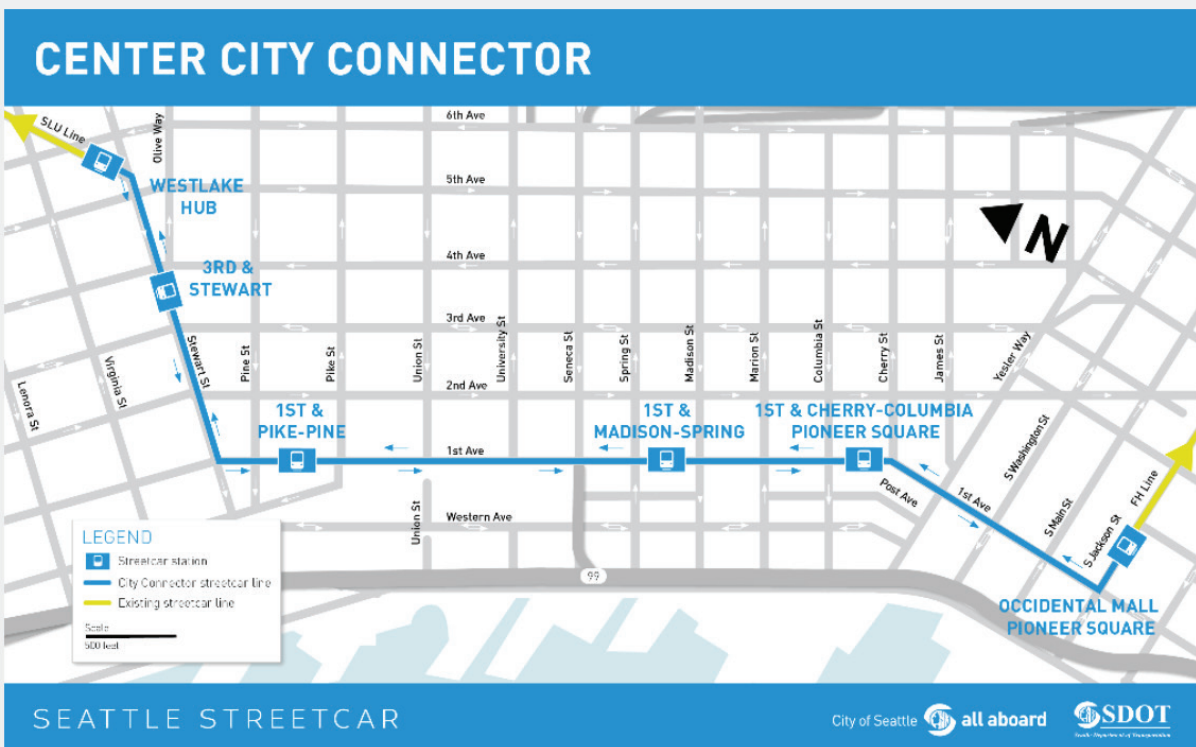
- 5** total miles of streetcar line connecting Seattle's densest neighborhoods

- 23** total streetcar stations
