



MAJOR CONSTRUCTION BEGINNING LANE CLOSURES ON 1ST AVE S AND S JACKSON ST

Starting as soon as January 2, northbound lanes on 1st Ave S will be closed between S Jackson St and Yesler Way while we relocate and replace utilities. Closing both northbound lanes allows space for crews to perform the work safely and efficiently. We'll keep intersections and a southbound lane open during the day with intermittent closures at night and on weekends. Northbound 1st Ave S will be detoured at S Jackson St.

We'll also close the westbound lane on S Jackson St from 2nd Ave S to 1st Ave S. Local access will be available by way of Occidental Ave S. S Jackson St will be detoured at 2nd Ave S.

This work will continue for about 6 months.

NIGHTTIME INTERSECTION WORK

To reduce traffic impacts during peak travel times, crews plan to work in intersections at night. We'll provide advance notice through our email updates once we get closer to this work.

To help minimize nighttime noise, crews will:

- Complete pavement-breaking work before 10 PM
- Restrict the use of pure tone back-up warning devices after 10 PM and before 7 AM weekdays and 9 AM weekends

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Daytime construction hours: 7 AM - 5 PM weekdays
- Nighttime construction hours: 5 PM - 7 AM weekdays and some weekends
- Sidewalk access will be maintained
- Parking and travel lane restrictions and detours for people driving
- Alley access will be maintained with the exception of the south end of Nord Alley, which will be blocked by water main construction
- Some temporary water shutdowns (see back for more info)
- Typical construction impacts such as increased dust, noise, vibration, and truck activity

WATER SHUTDOWNS

Starting as soon as January 2, crews plan to install a temporary water main along the curb and connect it to buildings on both sides of 1st Ave S between S Jackson St and Yesler Way and on a small section of S Jackson St.

We'll share more details as the work gets closer, but please expect:

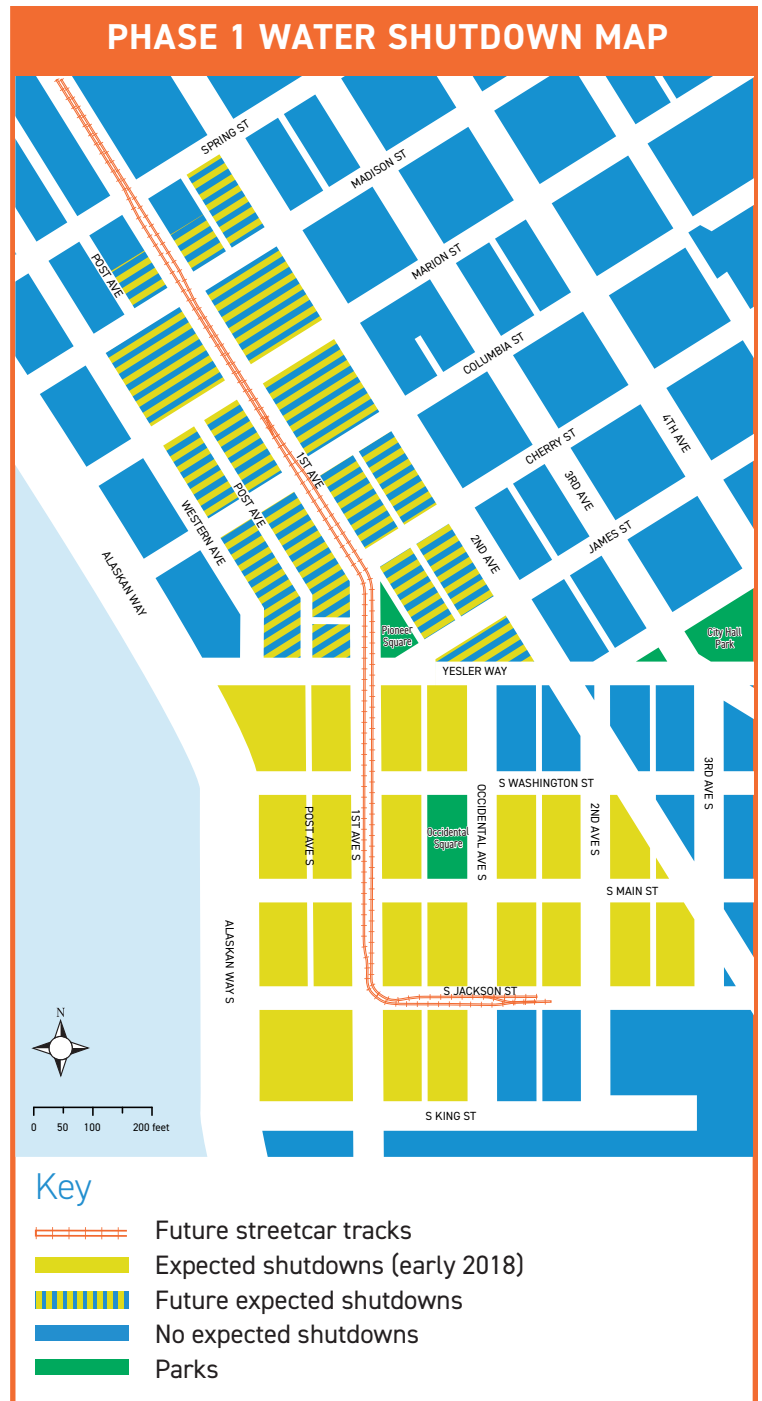
- Temporary water shutdowns for some customers
 - Seattle Public Utilities (SPU) is working closely with building managers and businesses to determine the best times for water shutdowns
- Each impacted customer will experience about 2 short (2- to 4-hour) shutdowns and about 2 long (8- to 10-hour) shutdowns while the new water main is being installed along the streetcar alignment; however, individual impacts will vary

OTHER WORK IN THE AREA
